



Memory Verse

Our Bible verse today tells us that God helps us get through any hard or scary situation!

We don't have to be afraid because God is with us and He promises to meet all our needs.



Read Exodus 1-2

This week we began our new series studying the life of Moses. There is so much we can learn from his story, even as a young boy! Answer the following questions to reinforce the importance of trusting God even when we feel out of control.

- 1. What does it mean to protect someone?
- 2. How did God protect Moses as a baby?
- 3. How does God protect you?

Story Summary (parents or older kids to read)

What a great story! Even as a baby, God had an amazing plan for Moses! God protected baby Moses throughout the entire Bible story!

You know, sometimes when we don't know what's going to happen, we can tend to feel scared, overwhelmed or even frustrated. But the Bible tells us that God is in control today just like He was in control during the time of Moses.

Even though Moses was in a scary situation, God was in control and protected Moses! Moses' mother also put her trust in God even though she didn't know exactly what was going to happen. This shows us how we can always put our trust in God regardless of what hard thing we're facing or going through.

Sometime, the uncertainties we face in life can make us feel like we're losing control. But that helplessness is the perfect reminder that we need to rely on God.

We can even see the trust in God represented by Moses' mother when she decided to trust God with the life of her son! And we can see how God rewarded her trust by protecting Moses when he was a child.

We can take comfort in knowing that God is always in control and He has a plan for each and every one of us. But more importantly, He loves us and doesn't want us to worry. We can always put our trust in God no matter what we are going through because God is with us and He loves us. He promises to meet all of our needs!
